Through this petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners have prayed for quashing of FIR No. 5 dated 29.6.2016, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station NRI, District Moga (Annexure P-1) and the proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 06.12.2016 (Annexure P-2) entered into between the parties.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners states that the trial in the impugned FIR is ended in acquittal of the petitioners vide judgment dated 04.1.2019 passed by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class,
