MANOJ BAJAJ, J.(ORAL)

 This revision petition challenges the Appellate Court order whereby judgment of acquittal passed by the trial Court in case FIR No.32 dated 16.03.2002 for the offences under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Tapa was upheld.

 Learned counsel for the petitioner states that FIR No.32 dated 16.03.2002 for the offences under Sections 420, 467, 468, 477 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Tapa, was recorded, wherein it was alleged that Will dated 14.03.1991 executed by Bikkar Singh @ Bikram Singh was a forged document. The said Will was also challenged by filing a civil suit as well. It is pointed out that the civil suit brought by the complainant (petitioner) was

dismissed and the said judgment and decree has been upheld by the Supreme Court of India as well.

In view of above, this Court does not find any reason to interfere with the judgment of acquittal.

The present petition is dismissed.
