Petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated 9.4.2019 (Annexure P-1), passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Faridabad, vide which an application of the present petitioner filed under Section 10 CPC was dismissed.

It comes out that the present petitioner had filed a civil suit for declaration, permanent and mandatory injunction against Kanwal Singh Dalal, Ajeet Singh Dalal and others in the year 2015. Now Ajeet Singh Dalal and Kanwal Singh Dalal filed a civil suit for permanent injunction against Vikram Dalal, who is a plaintiff in the previous suit. It is not disputed that in the previous suit, the defendants who are now plaintiffs in the subsequent suit, have not made any counter claim for injunction against the present petitioners. As Ajeet Singh Dalal and Kanwal Singh Dalal are seeking injunction against the plaintiffs in the previous suit, it is more appropriate if both the suits be clubbed and tried together to avoid conflicting views and contradictory findings.

As such, the present revision is disposed of with the direction to the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Faridabad that previous suit filed by Vikram Dalal stands consolidated with subsequent suit bearing CS No. 2720 of 2017 dated 14.11.2017 titled as Ajeet Dalal and another v. Vikram Dalal and shall be decided together.
