FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 15.10.2019 of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has been received whereby after recording statements of the private respondents, namely, Sukhbir Kaur and Kulwant Singh and accused/petitioners, namely, Rajdeep Singh, Ranjit Singh @ Rana and Wazir Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.172 dated 05.10.2015 registered at Police Station Kambo, District Amritsar under Sections 354-C, 506, 452 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 67 of the I.T. Act, 2000 and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 452 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act were deleted later on) and all consequences arising out of the said FIR *qua* the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
