FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 20.03.2019 of the learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, has been received whereby after recording statements of respondents Kamaldeep Singh @ Kamaljit Singh @ Monu, Satvir Singh and Hiteshwar Singh @ Mohan

and accused/petitioners, namely, Iqbal Singh, Karamjit Singh, Kewal Singh, Mandeep Singh, Sandeep Kaur, Kulwant Kaur, Harjit Kaur, Nirmal Singh, Sonu @ Khushwant Singh, Kuldeep Kaur, Sonu @ Baljinder Singh and Dharam Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of their own free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Moreover, during the course of interaction with the parties, they have shown their resolve to end the dispute and have made statements that they have compromised the matter as per Annexure P-3 and shall abide by the same.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the offence for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of DDR No.18 dated 15.08.2018 registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, under Sections 323/324/354/452/148/149 of the IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR *qua* the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
