The petitioner admittedly not having been apprehended at the spot, with, as per the case of the police, he having thrown away a plastic bag from which 270 grams of intoxicating powder are stated to have been recovered and he in fact having surrendered before the trial Court upon directions given by this Court after his petition seeking anticipatory bail was rejected, and further, he having remained in custody for the past three months, in the aforesaid circumstances, I consider it appropriate to allow this petition.

Without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, the petition is allowed with the petitioner to be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
