Petitioner Sukhdev Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.98 dated 11.07.2018, registered at Police Station Haibowal, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, under Sections 307, 201, 34 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 30 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant have appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

The allegation against the present petitioner is only that his revolver has been used in the occurrence. There is no allegation that he caused any injury or he actively participated in the occurrence.

The petitioner has been in custody since 13.07.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
