The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 45 dated 26.02.2019 under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that 1 kilogram and 600 grams of poppy husk has been recovered from co-accused Tinku, who is the brother of the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been implicated only because he is the brother of the main accused. No recovery has been effected from the petitioner. Co-accused Tinku has been granted regular bail by this Court. He further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case of similar nature.

This Court, by order dated 14.05.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Head Constable Satyawar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 14.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
