Affidavit of Inspector General of Police, Crime-I, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh has been filed, along with Annexure R-1 comments of Inspector General of Police, Crime, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab. The concluding part of the recommendations made by Inspector General of Police Crime-I, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, Chandigarh, are extracted as under:-

“However, it is also important that the informant of the FIR and father of murdered Rajinder Singh should be satisfied with the investigation of the case. Keeping in view the prayer of the petitioner Gian Singh, it is recommended that investigation of the case may be transferred and entrusted to a newly created Investigation Team of Homicide and Forensics Unit of Punjab Bureau of Investigation (PBI), which will conduct investigation under the immediate supervision of Superintendent of Police, PBI, Roopnagar district and the overall supervision of the senior officers of Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, through the Inspector General of Police, Bureau of Investigation (presently B.O.I. And erstwhile Crime Wing), Punjab.”

In view of the aforesaid, present petition is disposed of by requesting the Special Investigating Team to conclude the investigation within a period of 3 months.
