As per pleadings on record, petitioner no.1 was married to respondent no.4 on 6.6.2013. A daughter was born out of the wedlock namely Sandeep Kaur (petitioner no.2 herein) and who is currently 3 years of age.

Instant petition has been filed seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents under the State of Haryana to take necessary steps for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 11.

Counsel submits that the matrimonial relationship between petitioner no.1 and respondent no.4 has gone into rough weather and currently both the petitioners are staying at the parental house in Fatehabad. It is contended that husband of petitioner as also her in-laws are maltreating her and have resorted to frequent beatings and as such, there is a threat to the life and liberty.

Having heard counsel for the petitioners at length and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the writ petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same with a direction to respondent no.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad to look into the matter against

the backdrop of a complaint/representation dated 1.5.2019 (Annexure P-2) that is stated to have already been made and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
