TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner who was serving on the post of Revenue Accountant under the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited had filed the instant petition raising a grievance that his request for voluntary retirement in view of Regulation 3 (3) (b) of the PSEB Service (Pre-mature Retirement) Regulations 1982, was not being processed.

On the last date of hearing, Mr. Sahil Sharma, Advocate, had been furnished a copy of the writ paper-book so as to complete instructions.

Counsel representing the Corporation apprises the Court that an order dated 23.05.2019 has since been passed, relieving the petitioner from his assignment and by accepting his request for voluntary retirement. It is further submitted that such decision had been taken without prejudice to any disciplinary proceedings/recovery proceedings that may have already been initiated or may be initiated in future but in accordance with law.

In view of the stand taken on behalf of Corporation, nothing survives for adjudication in the instant petition and the same is disposed of as infructuous.
