ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners, who mother and daughter. It is further prayed that respondent No.5 be restrained from interfering into 16 kanal of land, which was transferred by him as permanent alimony in favour of his wife-petitioner No.2 Beant Kaur.

On the last date of hearing, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and respondent No.5 has made a statement to the following effect: -

“....Stated that I am resident of the above mentioned address.

Today in my full conscious and without any pressure I am making

this statement that I will not interfere in the land which I have given to my wife namely Beant Kaur-petitioner No.2 as full and final alimony in the matrimonial dispute (the land i.e. 2 acres was transferred as registered sale deed) and I have no objection if she will give the said land on a mortgage or sold or for cultivation by herself. That today I am present in the Court and on the direction of the Hon'ble High Court, I am getting my statement recorded in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre in the presence of Mediator. The contents of my above statement have been read over and explained to me in the language I understand and after admitting it correct I have put my signatures.”

In view of above statement of respondent No.5, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that this petition be rendered as infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

However, it is made clear that respondent No.5 shall be bound by the statement made before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
