This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 18.12.2018 passed in CWP No. 32400 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"On the asking of the court, Mr. Sahil Sharma, DAG, Punjab, who is present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. He submits that, in case, any enquiry is pending against respondent No.3, steps shall be taken for completion thereof at the earliest, in any case, not later than two months.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, no further direction is necessary. Disposed of."

Learned State counsel on instructions from Ms. Pushpa Rani, S.A. submitted that inquiry has been completed and the inquiry report shall be handed over to petitioner within two weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the statement made above, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present

contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedy against the inquiry report.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
