FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. by petitioner Ravisher Singh in case bearing FIR No.133 dated 14.06.2014 registered at Police Station Sadar, Tarn Taran under Sections 363, 366, 376-A, 506 IPC wherein the trial Court has amended the charge under Section 376-D IPC by allowing an application moved under Section 216 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 25.10.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on bail, and has placed on record certified copy of the orders dated 12.11.2018, which is not controverted by learned State counsel assisted by ASI Harwinderpal Singh, Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 25.10.2018 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
