HARI PAL VERMA, J.(Oral)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directions to respondent Nos.1 to 5 to take appropriate legal action against respondent Nos.6 to 10 for brutally and openly molesting petitioner No.1 and they have caused grievous injuries on the person of petitioner No.2. Respondent Nos.6 to 10 have also abused them by name of their caste with a further prayer to respondent Nos.1 to 5 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.6 to 10.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Ramandeep Singh Bhullar, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, (West), Ludhiana, has already been filed on behalf on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. As per reply, the police has conducted an inquiry on the application dated 07.11.2017 so submitted by the petitioners. Petitioner No.1-Kiranpreet Kaur has got her statement recorded with the police that she has moved the application dated 07.11.2017 under the pressure of her husband, brother-in-law Jarnail Singh and mother-in-law, so that pressure could be created upon respondent Nos.6

to 10. However, now she is not interested to pursue the said application and the application dated 07.11.2017 be consigned in the office. Statement of petitioner No.1 has been attached as Annexure R-1/T. She has also got her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. before the court of Ms. Indu Bala, JMIC (Duty), Ludhiana on 15.05.2018, wherein she has stated that the application was moved by her husband falsely. Moreover, on 25.07.2017, petitioner No.2-Vasakha Singh, his father Karnail Singh and two other persons caused grievous injuries to Amanpreet Singh @ Tanman and Sukhdeep Singh, resident of village Fagla, Ludhiana. On the statement of injured Sukhdeep Singh son of Karnail Singh, resident of village Fagla, District Ludhiana, an inquiry was conducted by the police and after inquiry, FIR No.122 dated 28.07.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34, 341 IPC, was registered at Police Station Ladhawal, Ludhiana against petitioner No.2-Vasakha Singh, his father Karnail Singh, Dhama and Neeta. Thereafter during the investigation, offence under Section 326 IPC was added in the FIR, whereby the injuries were declared sharp by the doctor vide MLR No.34852 dated 25.07.2017 of Amanpreet Singh and MLR No.34853 dated 25.07.2017 of Sukhdeep Singh. The copies of MLRs have also been annexed as Annexures R-2 and R-3.

Since the very complaint so submitted by the petitioners has been found to be false for which reply by way of affidavit has been filed, this Court finds that the present petition deserves to be dismissed.

Accordingly, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
