FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, states that petitioners No.1 to 5 namely Ranjit Singh, Ramandeep Kaur, Balwinder Singh, Simran Kaur and Manjit Kaur have since been found to be innocent and acquitted vide judgment and order dated 25.07.2019 passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kapurthala and thus the petition qua them has been rendered infructuous; however, in respect of petitioners No.6 to 8 namely Waryam Singh alias Rama, Kuldeep Singh and Sukhwinder Singh, he states that they have been declared as proclaimed offenders vide order dated 20.05.2019.

In view thereof and in the light of law laid down in '**Lavesh vs. State**' (2012) 8 SCC 730, nothing sustains in this petition and the same stands dismissed accordingly.
