The grievance of the petitioners herein is that their services have not been regularized. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 joined the services in 1981 while petitioner No.2 is serving the respondents since 1994. The respondents have created 417 posts of Daily Wage Workers for regularizing the services vide letter dated 21.12.2015(Annexure P-15), still the benefit thereof has not been accorded to the petitioners. In the premise, the petitioners also caused legal notice dated 04.02.2019(Annexure P-10) which was not adverted to by the respondents.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Anu Chatrath, Sr. Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG Punjab puts in appearance on behalf of respondents-State.

Given the nature of order being passed and keeping in view the aforesaid, no further proceedings or pleadings are warranted in this case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to pass a speaking order by objectively considering the contentions as raised in the legal notice dated

04.02.2019(Annexure P-10) along with the contents of the instant writ petition by treating the same as supplementary representation as also keeping in view the contention of learned counsel for the petitioners, as noted above, in accordance with law.

Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In the event the petitioners are found entitled to the benefits, as claimed by them, the same be accorded to them within a period of two months thereafter.
