Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to transfer of investigation of FIR No.4 dated 18.01.2019 registered under Sections 199, 200, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 496 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Balianwali, District Bathinda as the respondents/accused have not been arrested till date.

On 20.09.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab is directed to find out the status of investigation in FIR No.4 dated 18.01.2018 registered under Sections 199, 200, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 496 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Balianwali, District Bathinda.

Counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply three sets of paper book to the learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 16.10.2019.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Chamkaur Singh has apprised the Court that three accused, namely, Jagrup Singh, Jaswinder Kaur and Butta Singh have been extended the concession of anticipatory bail and pursuant to the said concession, they have joined the investigation. Accused, namely, Amandeep Kaur and Manpreet Singh i.e. respondent Nos.6 and 7 respectively, are absconding and efforts are being made to arrest them. It is further apprised that accused, namely, Dalip Kaur-respondent No.9 was found innocent.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any reason to transfer the investigation of the case.

Resultantly, petition is dismissed.
