Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.20 dated 02.02.2018 under Sections 452, 325, 308, 506, 34, IPC, Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the prosecution agency after investigation could not find any incriminating material/evidence against the petitioner and therefore, he was put in column No.2. However, the petitioner has been summoned under Section 319, Cr.P.C. by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, has submitted that the investigation is complete. The petitioner is in custody for more than two months.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the

petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
