The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 27 dated 16.06.2016 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Qilla Lal Singh, District Batala, on the basis of compromise dated 18.07.2016 (Annexure P-3).

Pursuant to order dated 25.10.2018, Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala has submitted his report dated 11.01.2019 stating that the parties have effected compromise and that the same is genuine and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence. A perusal of the record shows that the injuries under Section 307 IPC are on the non-vital part of the body of the complainant/injured. The petitioners and respondents No. 2 to 4 belong to the same village and they have amicably settled their rancour against each other and have decided to live with peace and tranquility, as is apparent from the report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala.

In view of the above and the fact that the cross version of the FIR in question viz. DDR No. 4 dated 18.06.2016 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC registered in the same Police Station, has also been quashed, vide separate

order of even date, passed in CRM-M-46126-2017, the instant petition is allowed

and FIR No. 27 dated 16.06.2016 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Qilla Lal Singh, District Batala, and all the consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
