Petitioners Juned and Muffi @ Mafeed have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.639 dated 16.11.2012, under Section 379 IPC, registered at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh. On 25.10.2018, following order was passed :-

“Earlier the petitioners were on bail. However, they absented on 14.02.2018 and subsequently were declared proclaimed offender.

It has been submitted that no propere procedure for initiating the proceedings under Section(s) 82/83 Cr.P.C. has been adopted nor it was in their knowledge.

Notice of motion for 18.02.2019.

Meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to

surrender before the learned trial Court within seven days from today and on doing so, they shall be released on interim bail by that Court to its satisfaction.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Navneet Singh has apprised the Court that pursuant to order dated 25.10.2018, petitioner No.1-Juned has not submitted himself before the trial Court, however, petitioner No.2-Muffi @ Mafeed appeared before the Court on 31.10.2018, who was admitted on regular bail.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed qua petitioner No.2-Muffi @ Mafeed and it is ordered that he be allowed to remain on regular bail, as granted by the trial Court, pursuant to order dated 25.10.2018.

As far as petitioner No.1-Juned is concerned, the petition qua him is hereby dismissed as he has not complied the order dated 25.10.2018 passed by this Court.
