Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents No.4 to 7.

In pursuance to the notice of motion, the SHO, Police Station Tarn Taran has produced respondents No.4 to 7 before this Court.

The case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for recording the statement of petitioner No.1 and respondent No.7.

In the statement, petitioner No.1 has stated that she do not want to go back home and want to stay with petitioner No.2 of her own sweet will.

Similar statement has been made by petitioner No.2 – Jagjit Singh that he want to take petitioner No.1 to his house and settle his life as even his parents have no objection if petitioner No.1 resides with him.

Respondent No.7 – Simro, the grandmother of petitioner No.1 has stated that parents of petitioner No.1 have died and if she want to live with Jagjit Singh, it will be at her own responsibility and respondent No.7 do not own any responsibility in this regard.

In view of the above, considering the limited scope of the present petition that the petitioners are seeking protection of their life and liberty at the instance of respondents No.4 to 7, I find that there is no such apprehension in view of the statement of respondent No.7, this petition is disposed of accordingly.
