Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 82 dated 19.06.2009, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Jalandhar as well as all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

On instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh, learned State counsel has apprised the Court that as a matter of fact, the petitioner is not coming forward to join the proceedings before learned trial Court; rather declared as Proclaimed Offender on 13.02.2010, which was stayed by this Court way back on 12.02.2016.

Perusal of the paper-book reveals that consecutively for the last two dates of hearing none appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Today also there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.

Learned trial Court shall proceed in the matter according to law.
