This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No 0514 dated 21.9.2018 registered under Sections 395/397 IPC and 25 Arms Act and Section 120B and 216 IPC (added later on) at P.S. Dharuhera, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that similarly situated co-accused Sohanvir Singh and Kamruddin have already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 11.4.2019 passed in **CRM-M No.9498-2019 and CRM-M-14380-2018** respectively (**Annexure P-3**). Further, the petitioner has been in custody for more than six months.

Custody certificate dated 18.5.2019 by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Kumar-Dsm, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Gurgaon)-Haryana has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, the same is taken

on record. Copy has been supplied to the opposite counsel. As per which the applicant has undergone actual custody of almost 6 months and 2 days.

Learned Assistant Advocate General, on instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar has accepted that the petitioner is on same footing as aforesaid Sohanvir Singh and Kamruddin.

I see no reason to take a different view.

Regular bail to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
