Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.23 dated 30.03.2019 registered under Sections 420/120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Thermal, Bathinda.

Status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police has been filed, wherein it has been stated that the petitioner along with his wife and other co-accused had cheated various persons on false promise of migration to foreign country.

The investigations are in progress and other accused, who are not residents of State of Punjab, have also not been arrested.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court finds no good ground to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
