Present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of appropriate directions to Registrar (Judicial), of this Court, respondent No.1 herein, to get recovered the money from the respondent as per orders dated 26.11.2015 passed by this Court in Cr.W.P. No. 1668 of 2015.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that in Cr.W.P. No. 1668 of 2015, titled **Lachhman Dass Vs. State of Punjab and others**, following order was passed by this Court on 26.11.2015 :-

“ Keeping in view the above fact, no further action is required to be taken in this petition and the same is dismissed. As the petitioner has filed the second petition with a motive to harass the detinue and her family and further as the petition to the same effect has already been dismissed by this Court after the production of detinue, therefore, in these circumstances, I impose Rs.50,000/- as costs

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upon the petitioner for filing this frivolous petition. This amount will be deposited by the petitioner within one month from today for payment to the detenue Ms. Ashu Goyal. If the amount was not deposited, Registry will take action as per law for recovery of the amount.

3. Accordingly, on 6.2.2019, the petitioner had moved representation (Annexure P/3) to the Registrar (Judicial) for getting the recovery of Rs.50,000/- effected, but no action has been taken.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.1, i.e. Registrar (Judicial) of this Court to take required action in accordance with law as per orders passed by this Court dated 26.11.2015 in Cr.W.P. No. 1668 of 2015, titled **Lachhman Dass Vs. State of Punjab and others.**
