Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.14 dated 01.02.2019 under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Patiala.

On 05.07.2019 when the case was taken-up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted that the petitioner would settle the dispute with the wife for an amount of Rs.12 lakhs and this offer was accepted by learned counsel for the complainant on that day.

Accordingly, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Parties have appeared before the Mediator and the matter has been settled between them on 12.07.2019. The

report received from the Mediator is made part of the record.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of at this stage, however, with the direction to the respondent that in case presence of the petitioner is required in any manner, he shall be given a clear 15 days' notice, so as to avail the remedy in case he aggrieved by any such action.

The parties shall remain bound by the terms & conditions of the compromise dated 12.07.2019 so entered between them in letter and spirit.
