Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.81 dated 09.06.2018 registered under Sections 447, 354, 506, 34 of IPC at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

Vide order dated 14.05.2019 while issuing notice of motion in the case, arrest of the petitioners was stayed.

Counsel for the petitioners states that though only arrest of the petitioners was stayed, but still the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that since the petitioners have joined the investigation, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.05.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
