By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0254 dated 24.8.2018, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 324 and 379A IPC, (Sections 325 and 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Narnaund.

On 26.10.2018, this Court had passed the following order :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the present is a case of version and cross-version because an FIR No.253 dated 23.08.2018 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 341 and 506 IPC was also registered against the complainant and his family members at Police Station Narnaund, District Hisar at the behest of

petitioner No.1.

Notice of motion for 31.01.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the order dated 26.10.2018, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions of ASI Ramesh Kumar submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 26.10.2018, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
