The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.410 dated 11.7.2018 registered at Police Station Sector-5, Gurgaon, District Gurugram under Section 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 27/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959, wherein offences under Sections 30 and 59-A of Arms Act were added later on, and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 1.11.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurugram has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Ankit and Vinod Kumar and also of complainant Manjeet have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurugram has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (CrL.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.410 dated 11.7.2018 registered at Police Station Sector-5, Gurgaon, District Gurugram under Section 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 27/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959, wherein offences under Sections 30 and 59-A of Arms Act were added later on and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
