It is stated that the petitioner has till today not reported to the Institute for joining his services. Counsel also stated that the work of the mill has been suspended since 2014.

 Petitioner has not put in appearance though a notice was sent to him and it was reported that he is not residing at the given address nor his address is known.

 In the circumstances, the writ petition is ordered to be consigned to record with liberty to the petitioner to get it revived, if need be.
