On 14.06.2019, the following order was passed:-

“It has been contended that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner nor he was present at the spot. Petitioner has not been properly served and no notice has been received by him.

Notice of motion for 02.09.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Arresting/Investigating Officer and join the investigation within 7 days. On doing so, he shall be released on interim bail, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

It is not in dispute that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Investigating Officer and joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Devinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for custodial interrogation, at this stage.

In view thereof, interim order dated 14.06.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
