This petition has been filed by petitioner, namely, Kailash for grant of regular bail to him in case FIR No.13 dated 08.01.2017 registered under Sections 302, 201/34 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Rai, District Sonipat.

At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that out of total 29 witnesses, 28 witnesses have already been examined and the trial is likely to be concluded as the date before the trial Court is fixed for 17.01.2019.

Keeping in view the stage of trial, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with a request that the trial Court may be directed to conclude the trial expeditiously as the prosecution witnesses have not supported the case of the prosecution.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the trial Court is directed to make all efforts to expedite the trial preferably within a period of six weeks.
