The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for the grant of regular bail in case FIR No.758 dated 12.12.2017 under Sections 379A, 411, 201 and 489 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Badshahpur, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner, along with his co-accused Dharmender Chauhan, is alleged to have snatched Wagon R Car from complainant-Juber Khan and their co-accused Nahim Ahmed is alleged to have subsequently dismantled the car and sold its parts. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. Complainant-Juber Khan has been examined in the case as PW-2 and he did not identify the petitioner to be the person who had snatched the car from him. Co-accused Nahim Ahmed has been granted regular bail by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class.

The bail application has been opposed by the learned State counsel who has argued that the petitioner, along with his co-accused, snatched car from the possession of complainant-Juber Khan and the petitioner is also involved in another occurrence of similar nature.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly that offences are triable by Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, the trial is likely to take long time and co-accused has been granted regular bail, I am of the considered view that the petitioner deserves the concession of regular bail.

Therefore, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing of personal and surety bond(s) to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Gurugram.
