The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the complaint No.30 dated 28.07.2014 filed by the respondents and summoning order dated 21.11.2014 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar and all consequential proceedings.

During the course of the pendency of the proceedings of the present petition the respective parties had shown their inclination to get the matter settled amicably. Therefore, the case was adjourned for the purpose of exploring possibilities of settling the dispute.

Today the counsel for the petitioners and the complainant in person, both submit that the matter has since been settled amicably. Therefore, a joint request is made by both the sides that the complaint and the proceedings under challenge in the present petition be quashed.

The agreement arrived at between the parties has also been produced before the court. The photocopy of the same is taken on record.

In view of the above said compromise and the statement made by both sides, the present petition is allowed. The complaint No.30 dated 28.07.2014 (Annexure P-1) filed by the respondents and summoning order dated 21.11.2014 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar and all consequential proceedings are ordered to be quashed.
