KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of the FIR No. 122 dated 25.8.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur (Anneuxre P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise.

Heard.

Vide order dated 26.10.2018, both the parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the trial Court and learned Magistrate was directed to submit its report.

Learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur vide its letter dated 20.12.2018 has submitted the report that statement of the complainant-respondent No. 2-Kuldeep Singh and the accused-petitioners namely Deepak Kumar, Manish Kumar @ Monu, Parampreet Singh @ Laddi, Sabjit Singh @ Vicky, Sunil Kumar @ Sethi, Sawan Singh, Rishi Kumar and Raj Kumar @ Babbu have been recorded. It is further reported that compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine; without any pressure, fear or coercion. Case is stated to be still pending for investigation.

Since the matter has been compromised and the trial of the case will be useless exercise, FIR No. 122 dated 25.8.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur (Anneuxre P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise qua petitioners stand quashed.

Petition stands allowed.
