Petitioner is seeking direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to decide the case of promotion to the post of Elementary School Head Master in HES-III (School Cadre).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that vide appointment letter dated 21.04.1998 (Annexure P-1), petitioner was appointed as Sanskrit Teacher w.e.f. 21.04.1998. Pursuant to the judgment dated 22.12.2016 passed by this Court in CWP-4301-2013 (Annexure P-2), respondents have promoted various Sanskrit Teachers as Elementary School Head Masters in HES-III (School Cadre) vide order dated 01.12.2016 (Annexure P-3). Grievance of the petitioner is that her case for promotion has not been considered only on the ground that she was not party to the aforesaid writ petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the communication dated 08.06.2012 (Annexure P-5), whereby case of the petitioner for promotion has been sent by the Principal, Govt. Girls Sr. Secondary School, Charkhi Dadri to the District Education Officer, Bhiwani. But till date, no action has been taken by the respondents. Learned

counsel further refers to the order dated 01.12.2016 (Annexure P-3), whereby persons junior to the petitioner have already been promoted.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

At this stage, present petition is disposed of by giving direction to the Director, Elementary Education, Haryana-respondent No.2 to treat this petition as a representation and consider the case of petitioner for promotion keeping in view the recommendation made vide communication dated 08.06.2012 (Annexure P-5). In case, the petitioner is found to be eligible for promotion, she will be granted all consequential benefits along with interest at the rate of 6% per annum. This exercise be completed within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
