Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 145 dated 28.09.2012, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Lahori Gate, District Patiala.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he confines his prayer only to the extent that learned trial Court may be directed to expedite the trial.

The prayer seems to be justified and accepted, therefore, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the learned trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of four months positively from today.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed off with the observation made above.

Needless to say that the petitioners will be at liberty to raise all their pleas before learned trial Court in accordance with law.
