Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.128 dated 07.09.2018 under Sections 498-A, 34 IPC (Section 328 IPC (deleted later on) registered at Police Station Rewari Sadar, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to order dated 26.10.2018 of this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Singh, does not dispute the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 26.10.2018 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
