ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0056 dated 12.04.2019 under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar Rural.

On 15.05.2019 the following order was passed by this Court:

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the offence under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code is not made out on reading of the FIR. He further submits that there are no allegations with regard to abetment or instigation as defined in Section 106, IPC.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. A copy of the paper book be handed over to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Mr. Ramesh Sharma, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant.

Adjourned to 22.07.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to

furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Tirath Ram submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 15.05.2019 is made absolute.
