The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.501, dated 1.6.2018, registered under Sections 406, 420 of the IPC, at Police Station Sarai Khawaja, District Faridabad.

Counsel for the petitioner states that despite the last order, the complainants have not come forward to get the sale deed registered. Learned AAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Sanjay Kumar, states that in fact the complainants are no longer interested in getting the sale deed registered but they want their money back.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall

be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
