ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.23 dated 05.02.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324 and 506 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Barara, District Ambala (Haryana).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners are that petitioner No.1 (Naveen Kumar) and petitioner No.2 (Mandeep Kumar) had caught hold of the complainant and petitioner No.3 (Gulshan) had caused knife blow in the stomach of the complainant. He further contends that the incident was an outcome of a sudden fight between them and the matter has now been compromised. He also contends that the petitioners are about 18 years old and are not involved in any other case.

Ms. Neeraj Chandel, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant/respondent No.2 and states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Rajesh, states that the challan is ready and shall be filed before the competent Court shortly.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners, especially when the petitioners are about 18 years old, the matter has been compromised and the investigation has been completed, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
