The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions for entrusting inquiry/investigation pertaining to illegal carving out of colonies to Vigilance Bureau, Punjab or in the alternative to issue directions to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural to take appropriate action on his complaints dated 27.3.2017 and 9.3.2019 (Annexures P-1 and P-13) and complaints/letters dated 30.6.2017 and 15.3.2018 (Annexures P-7 and P-8).

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that some private developers/colonizers have carved out two illegal colonies namely 'Baba Deep Singh' and 'Asha Enclave' on agricultural land measuring 18 acres opposite International Airport at Sehchandar, Rajasansi, Amritsar, Punjab without obtaining permission to change the land use from the concerned department and without getting them approved and without obtaining any license from PUDA and other requisite permissions.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, Police District Amritsar Rural, Amritsar, Punjab to look into the matter and to take appropriate action warranted under law on complaint dated 27.3.2017 (Annexure P-1), complaint dated 30.6.2017 (Annexure P-7) and complaint 15.3.2018 (Annexure P-8) and to ensure that the matter is thoroughly inquired into and also to ensure that there is no illegal colonization in the area more particularly in view of the fact that such like illegal colonization near the airport could prove fatal. The needful be done within a period of three months from today. It is, however, clarified that this order is not to be taken as an expression on veracity of averments made by the petitioner.

A copy of this order alongwith complaint dated 27.3.2017 (Annexure P-1), complaint dated 30.6.2017 (Annexure P-7) and complaint 15.3.2018 (Annexure P-8) be sent to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, Police District Amritsar Rural, Amritsar, Punjab, so as to enable him to do the needful.
