This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.4 dated 12.8.2017 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code at Police Station NRI, SBS Nagar and to submit final police report.

Notice of motion

On the asking of this Court, Mr. V.G.Jauhar, Sr. DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of State.

Earlier, the petitioner has filed CRM-M-16548-2019 which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 10.4.2019 by passing the following order : -

“ This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.4 and 5 to arrest respondent No.6 in FIR No.04 dated 12.8.2017 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of Indian Penal Code at

Police Station NRI, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the concerned authorities to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to State of Punjab to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order within a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the State that the investigation in this case be conducted by a police officer not below the rank of Inspector and be completed without unnecessary delay.
