This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to take appropriate action against respondent Nos.5 to 8 and to recover the amount embezzled by them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, District Nuh-Mewat to consider and decide the representation dated 14.02.2019 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Vivek Saini, DAG, Haryana, in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Deputy

Commissioner, District Nuh-Mewat, to consider and decide the representation dated 14.02.2019 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
