In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner had deposited a sum of ₹1,42,750/- from his own pocket with Income Tax Department and the same has not being refunded to the petitioner by the respondents.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 15.02.2018, which is still pending and the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 15.02.2018 (Annexure P-6) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief, which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 15.02.2018 (Annexure P-6), the

present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
