The allegations against petitioner-Sumit Verma, in this first anticipatory bail application filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C in a case bearing FIR No.54 dated 11.09.2018, under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, have been levelled by complainant/wife-Monika Sharma.

The brief allegations are that marriage between the couple took place on 22.01.2017 and on account of matrimonial dispute, the present case was got registered. Complainant-Monika Sharma has come personally present in the Court and has been identified by ASI Paramjit Singh, Police

Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar, Mohali and has made a statement that since a compromise has been effected between her and the petitioner/husband, she does not oppose the grant of bail and has no objection, if the same is allowed.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, Police Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, has not offered any resistance to the same in light of the stand of the complainant.

In view of the same, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.10.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
