Challenge is to the order passed by the trial Court declaring the petitioner to be a proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that procedure as prescribed under Section 82 of the Code of Criminal Procedure was not followed. He further submits that the petitioner was never served personally.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within 10 days and apply for being released on bail. If such an application is filed, learned trial Court would release the petitioner on bail on its satisfaction subject to furnishing of personal bonds and surety bonds.

Keeping in view the assertions made, this petition is disposed of without issuing notice.

This order has been passed keeping in view the fact that the criminal complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 is pending against the petitioner.
