ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0052 dated 10.04.2019 under Sections 420 IPC and Sections 29/33/3(k) (i)((ii)(iii)(iv)(v)(vi)13 read with Rule 10(4),17,18,29,33 Insecticides Rules, 1971, Sections 19, 20 and Section 193 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Dharmkot, District Moga.

On 15.05.2019 the following order was passed by this Court:

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. A copy of the paper book be handed over to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 22.07.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Prem Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 15.05.2019 is made absolute.
