This order shall dispose off anticipatory bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. moved in FIR No. 74 dated 23.06.2017 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women Sector 17, Chandigarh.

The present case has been got registered on the complaint of complainant Preeti Luthra wife of petitioner alleging that their marriage took place on 22.06.2014. On account of demand of dowry, harassment and cruelty, the criminal dispute had arisen between the couple leading to the registration of the present petition.

Mr. Amandeep Saini, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have effected a compromise and has placed reliance on settlement/agreement dated 26.02.2018 arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, original copy of which has been placed on record and the same is not disputed by Ms. Aashima Mor, learned Additional Public

Prosecutor for U.T. Chandigarh assisted by ASI Satnam Singh, Police Station Women Sector 17 Chandigarh.

In the light of this admitted stand, it would be travesty of justice, if the petitioner is sent behind the bars and since the parties have effected a compromise, the interim order dated 08.12.2017 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
